BOARD MATTERS

Summer 2019 Board Meeting Schedule

During the Summer period, the Board held a conference call on August 27th following the summer break. The next conference call is scheduled for Tuesday, October 8th.

Home shipments below plan at end of 2nd quarter

Total home shipments at the end of the 2nd Quarter, ending August 31st, amounted to 378 homes averaging 63 homes per month. This shipment level is lower than plan shipments of 85 homes per month used as the basis of the 2019-20 budget estimates.

Agriculture Land Commission Secondary Homes Dialogue Continuing

Building upon the update provided in the 2019 Spring News Letter, the Board of Directors has focused on dealing with the challenges arising

from the introduction of Bill 52: 2018 Agriculture Land Commission Act, implemented on February 22, 2019.

The new legislation restricted the construction of secondary homes on non-operating farms within the Agriculture Land Reserve. As a result of MHABC activities and public pressure exerted during the spring, the Ministry of Agriculture (overseer of the Agriculture Land Commission) elected to grandfather the previous legislative provisions for one year from the implementation date of the Bill 52 provisions. The next deadline is February 22, 2018 at which time the full Bill 52 constraints will, once again, come into effect.

In seeking a longer-term strategy to address the provincial government's goal of maintaining farmland while allowing continued construction of secondary homes on some categories of lands with the ALR, the Board is continuing dialogue with the Ministry of Agriculture officials.

By-Laws Being Updated

With the direction provided by the Membership during the 2019 Annual General Meeting, the MHABC's by-laws are being updated. The changes include changing the term Dealers to Retailers, establishing Board term limits, updating the Nominations Committee process and including language mandating MHABC policy statements on safety, financial management and human relations. The Board is reviewing proposed updates to the by-laws with approval anticipated this fall.

Board Nominations Committee Established

From the AGM direction to update the Nominations Committee process involving Board of Directors oversight, Directors Ken Jennings and Matthew Salmon have agreed to take on the task towards having a strong slate of Directors identified well in advance of the 2020 AGM. Members interested in MHABC governance are asked to contact Ken or Matt.



Transportation Matters

Transportation Director Ray Weicker held recent meetings with Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement Branch officials on numerous matters including day-time travel pilots and dimensions.

CVSE's Jan Lansing advised that formal review processes are underway or are pending at which time many of the topics will be addressed. In the interim, the MHABC is advocating for designation of Routes 3 (Rock Creek to Castlegar) and Route 33 (Kelowna to Rock Creek) as 5-meter wide routes. In addition, the MHABC is proposing changes to height criteria in Section 4.3 of the Commercial Transport Procedures Manual.

Marketing Program Webinar Series

The MHABC's Marketing Program is managed by FRESH INC. In this capacity, FRESH INC undertakes many duties ranging from managing MHABC.com, communications strategy development and delivering social media programs

towards increasing public awareness on our industry and the benefits provided.

In ensuring Member awareness on marketing, FRESH INC is offering webinars to inform Members on using associated tools. The first webinar is scheduled for 9 am on Thursday, September 26th.
